The Book of Revelation

- **Revelation as a Meal, Not a Manual**
 - Rev. 10:9 — “Take and eat...” Revelation must be consumed, not just studied.
 - A glory feast that satisfies the craving for union with Jesus.
- **The Language of Heaven**
 - Symbols = God’s parables in pictures.
 - Learning Revelation is like learning a new language—slow, patient, Spirit-led.
 - Hebrew itself was pictures—God has always spoken this way!
- **Challenge** → Will you eat this scroll until it changes your DNA?

Purpose of Revelation

- **Not stress, but blessing.**
- **Not fear, but fiery love.**
- **Not the end, but the unveiling of Christ.**
- **To Unveil Christ within His Bride.**

Jesus Unveiled in Glory (Chapters 1–5)

- **The Priest-King** (Ch. 1) – Hair blazing white, eyes of fire—this is no meek carpenter.
- **The Lover of the Church** (Chs. 2–3) – Walking among the lampstands, still tending His Bride.
- **The Slain but Victorious Lamb** (Chs. 4–5) – Heaven’s anthem: *Worthy is the Lamb!*
- **The Center of It All** – Revelation isn’t about beasts, dragons, or timelines—it’s about Jesus.
- **Challenge** → Can you shift your focus from *what’s coming* to *Who’s coming*?

Jesus the Refining Fire (Chapters 6–18)

- **The Judge, Not the Judgments**
- **The Throne, Not the Beast**
- **The Lamb, Not the Dragon**
- **Revelation as Fire** – refining, purifying, stripping away false power.
- **God’s “Supernatural Drama of His Best”** – not Satan’s worst.
- **Challenge** → What if the shaking is not the end of you, but the beginning of Christ’s fullness in you?

The King and His Bride (Chapters 19–22)

- **The Conquering King (Ch. 19)** – Rider on the white horse, with four names.
- **The New World (Chs. 20–22)** – New name, new song, new Jerusalem, new heaven, new earth.
- **The Bride Revealed** – not just a city but a people, shining with God’s glory.
- **Glory Defined** – Christ expressing Himself through human vessels.
- **Challenge** → Will you live unveiled, as His Bride, His partner in glory?

Core Takeaways (The Big “Unveil”)

1. Focus on the **Judge**, not the judgments.
2. See the **Lamb**, not the dragon.
3. Keep your eyes on the **Throne**, not the beast.
4. Desire the **New Jerusalem**, not fear Babylon.
5. Fix your eyes on the **Glory of God**, not the darkness.
6. Celebrate the **Overcomers**, not the failures.
7. Above all—see **Jesus Christ**, not the antichrist!
